With that in mind, we have identified 3 levels that patients generally relate to relative to addressing their dental needs/desires. It is important to understand that no one level is better than another. To help us appropriately and personally relate to your individual needs, please indicate below which level you most identify with at this time. It is not uncommon for patients to choose a different level as things change in their lives. However, this helps us to connect as a starting point. ***Be confident that regardless of where you are at with your dental needs/desires, we treat ALL PATIENTS with the same level of care, compassion and quality.*** We look forward to our ongoing relationship and helping you achieve the level of dental care most appropriate to you.

**Level 1**

Patients at this level are generally interested in addressing only the most urgent problem(s) versus discussing a more comprehensive or long term oral health plan. (Examples: tooth/mouth pain, broken teeth, loose teeth, bleeding gums, bad breath)

**Level 2**

Patients who choose this level generally want a comprehensive exam and wish to be Proactive in addressing ways to prevent future problems. (Examples: replacing old and worn fillings, periodontal treatment, replacing missing teeth)

**Level 3**

Patients who choose this level generally want a comprehensive exam and wish to be proactive in addressing ways to PREVENT future problems. Additionally, they are seeking information on elective procedures which will enhance the overall appearance and function of their smile and or bite. (Examples: Implant retained dentures, veneers, cosmetic crowns, orthodontics and whitening)
